Malawi is located in southeastern Africa, and I will be traveling with Bruce Main, the President and Founder of UrbanPromise. Along the way, our group will visit several UrbanPromise ministry sites.

UrbanPromise International (UPI) is an organization whose mission is to prepare emerging leaders to initiate, develop, and sustain Christian-based youth development organizations and to seed their new ministries as they serve vulnerable children and teens in our world's most under-resourced communities.

In addition to biking, we are raising money to help fund UrbanPromise children's programs for more than 3,000 children in Malawi. Every dollar donated will go directly towards this goal. Our goal as a group is \$50,000.

Session Notes – April 17, 2023

- We opened our meeting together with the lighting of the Christ candle and devotions led by Pastor Stephen Choi.
- Our Summer Worship Schedule will begin on Sunday, June 11. Worship services will be at 10:00 a.m. through the first Sunday in September.
- The last day of Sunday School will be Sunday, June 4. Sunday School for children will resume on Sunday, September 10.
- We made the prayerful decision to give an additional \$250 to the Greenwich Township Emergency Squad and a donation to the Wagner Family.
- Our Deacons purchased 25 songbooks/hymnbooks for the Lopatcong Care Center. The Deacons also sent 5 care packages and 1 gift card to our college and graduate school students in April.
- We formed a health committee, and we plan to have a discussion about Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) at our next session meeting.
- Judy Melchore will be attending her first presbytery meeting as a Ruling Elder Commissioner on Tuesday, May 9. (The Presbytery of the Highlands has 5 presbytery meetings a year.)
- We made the decision to change the time of next year's Good Friday Service to 7:00 p.m. (It has been at 7:30 p.m.)
- Approval was given to Stewartsville Grange #121 to use Roan Hall on Saturday, April 29 and Saturday, May 6.
- Our next session meeting will be on Monday, May 15.
- Treasurer's Report:
As of March 31, we have a year-to-date deficit of \$946 in our General Fund Budget.
- As we concluded our meeting, we committed to praying for one another and our church, lifted up our joys and concerns, and closed with the Lord's Prayer.
