

Pray for This Week's Mission Partner: Community FoodBank of NJ. The Community FoodBank of NJ fights hunger and poverty in New Jersey by assisting those in need and seeking long-term solutions. They package food orders for local soup kitchens and food pantries; purchase and collect food for distribution; help people in need through SNAP application assistance; reach communities with limited resources with mobile pantries; and encourage others to get involved. Last year, they distributed food for over 86 million meals (more than 103 million pounds).
