Congratulations and blessings on 175 years of ministry. Having been connected to SPC for nearly 75 of those years, I have a lot of memories. I'll share one that meant a lot to me and, in a way, set me on my own course of ministry.

For me and my childhood friends, things really got interesting when the new "Rev" came to our little town – that would be the Rev. Charles Jessen, "da Rev." He started a youth group, took us on retreats to Krumsville, and basically kindled the Spirit at our little church.

One night after youth group, and after Rev had retired to the manse next door, my sister, Freddie and Dave Gary, and I went into the sanctuary. We flipped on the lights and the microphones, my sister Pat turned on the organ, and we lined up like the Temptations and started singing "My Girl." We were singing our hearts out and dancing like the Temptations.

What we didn't know was that Pat accidentally switched on the steeple chimes and the whole town could hear "My Girl" playing down past Seiple's store. Rev came running in, and I thought he'd be mad, but he wasn't. In fact, he said if we wanted to sing, we could any time other than at 10:00 p.m. on a Sunday night, when most of Stewartsville was getting ready for bed.

We began singing during worship services, and even at other churches. I learned then that faith is not some restrictive thing, as we so often see, but fun and full of joy! That lesson has been with me over the years, and even though I officially retired 5 years ago, I still carry that joy.

And whenever I hear the Temptations singing "My Girl," I smile and think of Rev and the Stewartsville Presbyterian Church.
