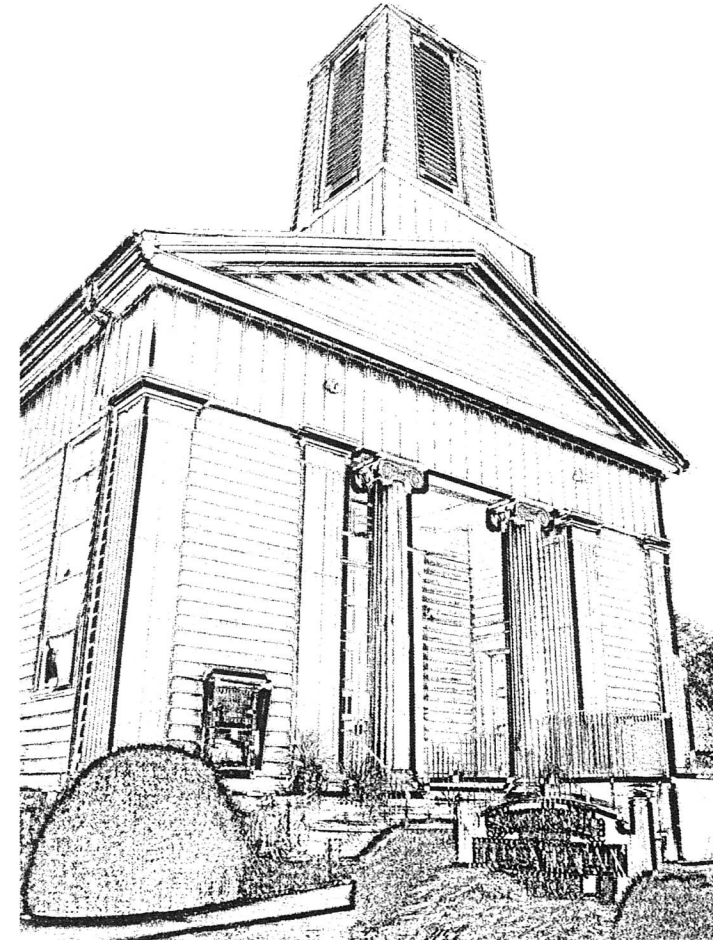

UrbanPromise Fellow. Today, we are joined by Hudson Musuuza, our UrbanPromise fellow. He is married, a father, and the 4th child in a Christian family of 12 siblings from Uganda. Raised through seasons of poverty and hardship, his painful childhood experiences shaped his deep passion to serve vulnerable children and youth across Uganda.

Driven by faith, Hudson founded Boundless Love Ministries Africa, a mission dedicated to transforming lives through hope, education, discipleship, and community empowerment. Once known as “the boy with torn pants,” Hudson now carries a God-given vision that is impacting the lives of many.

Hudson received a Master of Science degree from Cairn University in Pennsylvania, and his life message continues to inspire others to believe that no circumstance is beyond God’s power to redeem. For Hudson is made beautiful by grace.

Pray for This Week’s Mission Partner: Kiva. Kiva is an international non-profit organization with a mission to connect people through lending to alleviate poverty. By lending as little as \$25, anyone can help a borrower realize their potential.

Since March 2012, Stewartsville Presbyterian Church has made 656 loans totaling \$16,725 to people living in 88 different countries. We were able to do this with less than \$3,000. As we have been repaid, we are able to give new loans. To learn more about microfinance loans, visit kiva.org
